The Saints have gathered for millennia to listen to the words of the prophets. Can you find six differences in these pictures of King Benjamin's address?








*President Monson served in the U.S. Navy Reserves. *Elder Perry was a Marine in World War II. *Elder Nelson was an Army doctor during the Korean War.


*Elder Christofferson was a Captain in the U.S. Army.

*President Eyring was in the U.S. Air Force.
























APOSTLE MISSIONS

A number of the members of the Quorum of the Twelve have served missions, follow the paths to find out where these four served.




Did you know:

- *Both President Monson and Elder Ballard served as Mission Presidents in Canada.


CONFERENCE TIC-TAC-TOE!

Prophets throughout the years have shared their message from a number of different locations. Match the prophet to his pulpit and his message to the world.




